


Phosphorus levels along with secchi disc reading reflect the enrichment level of the lake and determine the categorization of the lake and its vulnerability.


| <u>Categorization</u> | Clarity (Secchi) | Phosphorus |
|--|------------------|-----------------|
| Oligotrophic – Unenriched (few nutrients) | Over 5 m | less than 1ug/l |
| Mesotrophic – Moderately enriched | 3.5-4.9 m | 11 to 20ug/l |
| Eutrophic – Enriched (high levels of nutrients |) Under2.9 m | over 21ug/l |
